BCW is crowned 2019 NWLA Tournament Champs!

Final 2019 Standings/Recap:

- 1. BCW, 6-2, This team epitomized good fortune this year as Roeder outpitched every ace, while Crosley and Two-Bat formed a great tandem to help Neumann to his first winning season and a Championship.
- 2. MAW, 7-3, Bush wins tournament MVP, winning every game he pitched in. Young assembled a great roster but he ran out of gas twice in DE, having to work their way through the Loser's Bracket on a long Sunday. With Chandler and Colin, this team proved to be one of the best hitting teams as well in 2019.
- 3. HRL, 4-3, The wifflers next door rode Nick Neumann's arm off, while Gus Skibbe and Dr. Suess combined for number two pitcher success. Rookie Andrew Johnson helped this team prove they also had one of the best offensive teams in the tournament.
- 4. HWBL, 6-2, Adams drafted from his former leagues and had Hogan lead them to the promised land of fourth place. Speek did well on the mound in his tournament debut and Tomlinson added some big offensive moments when they needed it.
- 5. WWW, 4-2, Brice Clark's team put together quite a swell run with McElrath, Gannon, and Steffes. Everybody did their part and with some big games from Brice and Ryan, they found their way to the top 5 for this first time in this team's history.
- 6. KWL, 4-2, Mippey5 won some games with his bat, but ultimately were eliminated when he was on the mound. Detmar had some big wins as Gregory and Werner his well throughout 2019.
- 7. MNWA, 4-2, Not only did Trent put together a squad of buddies (he wanted Bush or Mippey5, but still ended up with some favorites, but his team made a run behind wiffle darlings Jonkman and Sibbet. Tomkins and Trent added some offense as MNWA is back in the top 8.
- 8. SWBL, 3-3, Meador drafted possibly the least amount of pitching depth, but by far one of the most athletic teams, high on contact and fielding. Meador, Hatt, and Cruz made some spectacular plays breaking the tournament record in double plays, while all of their wins coming only when Ayres pitched.
- 9. GBL, 3-2, Castelli and Strojny held their own, while Freeman also got some time on the mound. After the number one ranking in pool play, they lose to Roeder and BCW, then Jonkman and MNWA.
- 10. MLW, 2-3, Even though they had 3 rookies on their squad, this team was a surprising out of the top 8 finish. They had some great depth on all sides of the ball, but fell to some more experienced arms.
- 11. RPWL, 2-3, KVon was the stud for this team, but when they lose his games pitching, you know things were not going their way. Milstad had a decent rookie outing and Doug/Dylan had some offensive moments, but it was not enough to break the top 10.
- 12. BWBL, 2-4, Mark Belles returned but this team had some historic moments repeated. They sit Tommy Loftus in the first round and start Coyk, which in the end caused them to lose first round, then after just one DE win (Loftus), they fall and are left wondering if they made the same mistake again...
- 13. WILL, 3-3, Dangerfield Champs again! Bingnear, Skibbe, and Schultz tried their hand at being aces, but in the end it was this team's hitting that got them just this far. Davey will look for a better position at getting an ace in the 2020 fantasy draft.
- 14. BWACS, 2-4, Ronnie assembled the all-drinking team as him, Artim, Hardball, and Nelson drank their way to 14th place, but had a great time and won two games with Artim on the mound. They almost won their first round DE matchup in a nail biter against HRL, that only gave up one run total!
- 15. WSEM, 1-4, One win in DE from Bogad, but then neither him nor Newell could find the zone. This team had some offensive success with Mike V, Castle, and Bogad, but they never could get that breakout game they needed.
- 16. AWAA, 0-5, A great offensive team assembled, but McElrath never could get used to the clean balls and nobody stepped up on the mound, leading to lots of high scoring affairs that never went their way.
- 17. OCWA, 0-3, A shock to everyone as Lavelley and Berger threw well, but home runs plagued them in their losses to Hogan, Ayres, and Roeder. Sarno couldn't get used to the yellow as OCWA goes out early.
- 18. CCWB, 0-3, Dudas seemed to have assembled a squad worthy of some wins but their offensive never showed as Buzea, Lil Detmar, and Kujawa got out done by Artim, Freeman, and Loftus.
